The board is looking into the possible purchase of land north of the golf course. The land purchase would be approximately 4-5 acres and would run from the northwest end of the course (behind hole number one) and then north to the tree line and then east past number seven tee box. The cost of the land would be approximately \$75,000.

The reason for the purchase would be to build a new clubhouse behind the number two, blue tee teebox. We would like to eliminate having to cross the highway with the golf cars. Every year there's instances of close calls and this could be eliminated by building on the north side of the course.

Hole number seven would become hole number one obviously leading to current hole number six as the new hole number nine. We would be better able to monitor green fees having the clubhouse closer to the first tee and it would be fun to watch golfers come down hole number nine sipping a drink from the clubhouse deck. We would also be able to have a driving range.

First Security Bank has agreed to finance this purchase for us and we would put 15% down on the purchase. There's just over 600' of shoreline that we currently own that we would sell with the exception of the lot where the putting green is so we would have access to the lake for our pump house.

I think this would be great for the club. It would be much safer, we would have a driving range and we'd be able to watch more golf from the clubhouse. We would proceed with new clubhouse plans as we sold our lots on the lake. It does take away a closer view of the lake, but that's what we would give up to eliminate crossing the highway.

Everyone on the board is in favor of this move as we have had many discussions about it. But, something of this magnitude, we do not want to leave all our membership out of this. If many of you are completely opposed, we'll scratch the idea. It's that simple.
